Pentecost Sunday 2016

What is Pentecost Sunday?

The Greek word "Pentecost" means "fiftieth" and refers to the ancient Hebrew Festival of Weeks (Exodus 23:14-17), which began when the first fruits of the harvest were presented to God 50 days after the Passover. On this same day, 50 days after the resurrection of Christ, the Holy Spirit descended upon the Church of Jesus Christ (Acts 2). It has also been called Whitsunday. Pentecost Sunday is a Christian holiday celebrated in nearly all Christian traditions.
