Trinity Sunday 2016

What is Trinity Sunday?

Trinity Sunday is the first Sunday after Pentecost, when the church of Jesus Christ celebrates the Holy Trinity. Unique from all other religions Christians worship the one true Triune God. The doctrine of the Holy Trinity teaches that Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three Persons in One Godhead. They share the same essence or substance. Yet they are three "persons." God is this way within the Godhead and as known in Christian experience.

Trinity Sunday is a Christian holiday celebrated annually in nearly all Christian traditions.
